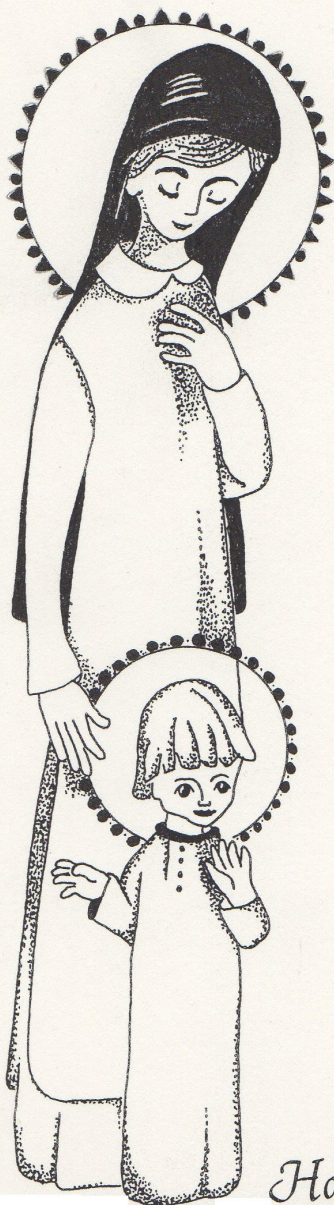
Boys: Dress Up! -khakis or nicer dress pants and nice shirt (polo, button-up, or sweater). Ties are great as well, but not required.
